- WHAT:** 100th Anniversary Girl Scout of Northern California Patch Contest
- DESIGNS DUE:** Patch designs need to be submitted by December 1, 2010 to GS NorCal Program Department. The winner will be announced in February 2011.
- CRITERIA:** All registered Girl Scout Daisy, Brownie, Junior, Cadette, Senior, Ambassador or Adult members are eligible to submit a patch design.

Patch Design must contain, but are not limited to:

1. 100th Anniversary or 1912 - 2012
2. "Girl Scouts" or "Girl Scouts of Northern California" or "GS NorCal"
3. Size – the finished patch will be a maximum of 4" x 4" and can be any shape.
4. Patch colors – Please use no more than 9 colors in the patch design.
5. Artwork should be original. No trademarked or copyrighted material will be selected unless it is the Girl Scout logo.

PATCH IDEAS: For 100 years, Girl Scouting has created girls of courage, confidence, and character, who make the world a better place. The 100th anniversary council patch should reflect the accomplishments of this amazing organization or what Girl Scouts means to you.

RESOURCES FOR IDEAS: Former and current Girl Scouts, research Girl Scout history online or at the library, check with your area Heritage Committee for resources, "experienced" Girl Scout Handbooks, and "The Golden Eaglet" Movie (which can be found on YouTube). Be creative and have FUN making your design!

CONTEST RULES:

1. Contest is open to any registered Girl Scout (Daisy to Adult)
2. Each person may submit one entry.
3. Individual entries only -Troops cannot submit one entry per troop only one per member.
4. GS NorCal retains the right to adjust designs if needed to ensure the image can be reproduced on a patch.
5. Only one design may be submitted per Contest Entry Form and per person.
6. By entering the design contest, artists allow the use of their first names, and/or photographs for advertising, publicity, or publication for this or similar promotions without further compensation.
7. Entries will not be returned and become the property of GS NorCal after submission.
8. Entries must be postmarked by December 1, 2010 to be considered for the contest.
9. Late, illegible, mutilated, or incomplete entries will not be considered.
10. The winner will be selected by the GS NorCal 100th Anniversary Committee and notified either via telephone, email or mail.
11. Entries will be judged based upon the criteria for the patch design (dimensions, colors, design elements).
12. GS NorCal new logo will be available to members after July 1, 2010. The new logo is being used early for this contest only and with special permission from GS NorCal MarCom Department.
13. Judges decisions are final.
