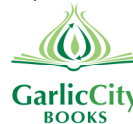

Half Moon Bay

This program serves girls through programming during school breaks and after school. Through a partnership with the Mid Peninsula Housing we are able to reach girl's whose families work in agriculture on the Coast. San Martin and Gilroy

Operating for over 20 years, this program operates for 11 weeks during the summer at three sites under the leadership of GSNC adult staff who are from the migrant community. The program seeks to develop positive peer and family relationships through literacy-based activities focused on conflict resolution, stress management, building healthy relationships, problem solving, diversity, and feelings. Parents also attend parenting classes and parent-child nights to increase healthy family communication.
