<b>Challenge Course &amp; Initiatives</b> <b>Up to 2 hours, cap. 24 participants</b> <i>Activities and challenges that focus on personal development and teamwork skills. From problem solving to communication and trust, facilitators will guide groups through activities and low ropes elements that will help build stronger teams. <b>Zip Line</b> <b>Up to 2 hours, cap. 20 participants</b> <i>Designed for the individual experience and will develop courage and confidence in participants as they climb through the cargo and descend the zip line through the trees. <b>Sampler for High Ropes Course</b> <b>2 ½ hours, cap. 20 participants</b> <i>A sampler session (1-2 elements) on the high ropes course. <b>Partial Day for High Ropes Course</b> <b>Up to 4 hours, cap. 24 participants</b> <i>Participants will be lead through a group development and teambuilding experience that will build courage, character and confidence. Groups will participate in elements that challenge both individual and team skills and have the opportunity to use at least 3 elements. <b>Full Day for High Ropes Course</b> <b>Up to 7 hours, cap. 24 participants</b> <i>Participants will be lead through both individual and team challenges including a range of elements and activities that build trust, communication, and teamwork. Participants will have the opportunity to learn some basic skills in climbing and belaying. <b>Independent Ground School provided by GSNorCal Staff</b> <b>1 hour, cap. 18 participants</b> <i>For programs that have scheduling restraints, an independent ground school option is offered. This is included in the program offerings above, but if you would like more direct climbing and participation time, this can be added on a day prior to the ropes course event.
