



ROPES COURSE RENTAL PROCEDURES AT SKYLARK RANCH

Hidden among the redwood trees in the Santa Cruz Mountains, Skylark Ranch offers a low element Challenge Course and a high element High Ropes Course for rental. We offer different options for groups to choose from when renting one of the ropes courses. Opportunities are available to build teamwork with your group, develop climbing skills, participate in an individual challenge through this ultimate high adventure activity, and more!

How To Rent the ropes Course:

- 1) To make a reservation, complete the online reservation request found on our website at www.camprocks.org. For questions, please contact Tori Barnes, Outdoor Program Director at 408-287-4170 ext 256 or by email at tbarnes@girlscoutsnorcal.org.
- 2) Once a reservation request is submitted you will be contacted to discuss the unique needs of your group and choose the best option for your activity or event.
- 3) Ropes Course Facilitators have been trained and certified to run programs on our low and high element courses. Anyone who leads a ropes course experience must have prior authorization from Girl Scouts of Northern California. Facilitators will be booked for you once you have picked the best option for your activity or event.
- 4) A \$100 deposit is required once your reservation is confirmed, and full payment is due 2 weeks prior to the event. A separate reservation and payment is required for site rental. Visit www.girlscoutsnorcal.org for more information on site rentals.

Option 1

Partial Day on the High Ropes Course
Participants will be lead through a group development and teambuilding experience that will build courage, character, and confidence. Groups will participate in elements that challenge both individual and team skills and have the opportunity to use at least 3 elements. Facilitators will guide a debriefing session at the end of the program.

Option 3

Full Day on the High Ropes Course
Participants will be lead through both individual and team challenges including a range of elements and activities that build trust, communication, and teamwork. Participants will have the opportunity to learn some basic skills in climbing and belaying. Facilitators will guide debriefing sessions at the end of the program.

Option 4

Challenge Course

Activities and challenges that focus on personal development and teamwork skills. From problem solving to communication and trust, facilitators will guide groups through activities and low ropes elements to will help build stronger teams.
